February 16, FOM Welcomed Decatur Medical and Dental team. Even though we call them the Decatur group they came from different parts of the US, El Salvador and Nicaragua. The group came eager and full of excitement to begin the mission the Lord had prepared for them.

This is their 9th year of ministry in the Valley of Peace. This year is our fourth year partnering with the Spanish Lookout Medical Clinic. **VOP the Dental team** served an average of 450 people in the dental clinic. 475 in the medical clinic. The Spanish Lookout clinic saw about 70 patients.

We know it is not about the numbers. However, we are excited about the most important of all the numbers. 80 people made a decision for Christ.
